SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

Special Education/Programs for Handicapped/Disabled/Exceptional Students

The district shall provide special education and training opportunities for each school- aged child residing in the district who has a mental, physical or psychological handicap or social maladjustment which impairs learning. Such services shall be provided within the district's schools or by other agencies under contract to the district as found most appropriate.

These services shall be provided in accordance with federal and state statutes and rules implementing or regulating these services in the district.

Regulations governing the district's special services and programs and related services provided in conjunction with such services and the related information are contained in the Rules and Regulations Governing Programs and Services for Handicapped Children published by the Wyoming Department of Education and adopted by the school district. These rules and regulations are contained in a separate volume and are available at the central administration office of the school district.
